Thanks to a kind invitation and hard work on local arrangements by Dr Viktor Šegrt, there will be a third Regional Meeting of SUME in Karlovac, Croatia, during Tuesday-Thursday 23-25 April 2019. This follows the Regional Meetings last year in Kyrgyzstan and Peru. Please see details of all on http://sume.sycl.net. This European meeting will be with the European Sustainable Use Group, like our inaugural meeting in Vienna in 2015, and is special, because we will be launching the global-with-local networking system mandated in SUME's terms of reference.

European Sustainable Use Group has been reaching agreements and raising the funding needed to underpin the system, and has just reached the point at which it is safe to proceed. Therefore a Content Committee is being formed, translation is being planned, and a new page will soon go on our website for what at the moment is called Naturalliance2. There will be training at the meeting for those of you who volunteer to translate and run web-sites in regional languages, with some support available for low cost travel and accommodation of those coordinators. The aim is to operate, when adequate funding is secured, in Amharic, Arabic, Bulgarian, Croatian, Czech, Dutch, Estonian, Farsi, Finnish, French, German, Greek, Hindi, Houssa, Hungarian, Italian, Japanese, Korean, Latvian, Lithuanian, Malay, Mandarin, Pashto, Polish, Romanian, Spanish, Swedish, Russian, Swahili, Thai, Turkish, Ukrainian, Urdu, Vietnamese and Zulu.

The meeting is scheduled for the week before the 7th IPBES Plenary, in Paris, in the hope that some of you may be able to come to Europe for both – perhaps spending the 4 days between meetings enjoying the beautiful spring countryside in Croatia.
